Saegertown Shooting Sports 2-22 aka S2Cubed

.22LR Two-Gun “Who Trains Wins”

Purpose

To get people out to shoot, move, and move and shoot in light kit while being price conscientious. And have fun doing so.

Safety

Obey all four rules of firearm safety:

1. Treat all firearms as if they were loaded
2. Never point a firearm at anything you are not willing to destroy
3. Keep your finger off the trigger until your sights are on target and you are ready to fire
4. Be sure of your target and what is behind it

Firearms with safeties must engage them while moving and yell “Safe”

Violating the “180 Rule” with a loaded firearm is a match disqualifier

All participants are looked upon as safety officers

Wear ear and eye protection

Use of chamber flags are required

Accidental and negligent discharges are match disqualifiers

Minors must have completed Hunter Safety Course and a parent or guardian present

Courses of Fire

Three to Five Stages depending on the number of attendees

Total of 90 rounds or less for all five

Magazines loaded up to 10 rounds

One stage handgun only

One stage rifle only

One to three stages of both

Youth participants will have similar, stationary courses of fires.

Shot Timer used to keep maximum time on the stage and tie breaking

Recommended & Needed Equipment

.22LR Handgun

.22LR Rifle

Two handgun mags

Two rifle mags

Gun-belt

Outside-the-waistband holster or approved chest holster (draw does not break 180 rule)

Rifle sling

Handgun mag carrier

Rifle mag carrier

.22LR conversion kits are permitted if they are safe and reliable

Distances

5 to 20 yards at the handgun range pit

25 to 100 yards at the rifle range

Targets

USPSA Targets at 100 yards for rifle and 50 yards for handgun

USPSA ½ Targets for everything else

Scoring

Alphas, Bravos, Charlies, Deltas, and Mikes:

Alphas – 5

Bravos and Charlies – 3

Deltas – 1

Mikes – 0

When

9am the third Saturday of the month May through August

The final match will be the third Saturday of September unless that is the VIPL Championship then it will be the second Saturday

The final match of the year will have three awards: Bronze, Silver, and Gold. Ranking will be dictated by the aggregate of all stages from the match. Shooters must attend one regular match to be eligible for an award at the final match.
